ZERO HIV STIGMA DAY IS JULY 21ST

July 21st marks Zero HIV Stigma Day, spearheading a movement and uniting people, communities, organizations, and entire countries to raise awareness and take action against HIV stigma, which reinforces and amplifies the HIV pandemic and related inequalities. HIV stigma refers to irrational or negative attitudes, behaviors, and judgments towards people living with or at risk of HIV.

Zero HIV Stigma Day is a joint initiative of NAZ and IAPAC in collaboration with the Global HIV Collaborative and Fast-Track Cities Institute. This day represents a movement to unite people, communities, and countries to help raise awareness about HIV sigma and learn about ways to help stop it.

This year's theme, "Beyond Labels: Redefining HIV Narratives," seeks to reshape perceptions, inspire empathy, and drive collective action toward a world free from HIV-related stigma.
